## **Guidelines for Oral and Poster abstract submission**

### **ABSTRACT PREPARATION**

Participants who intend to give oral or poster presentation must submit abstracts online at the conference website [www.ku-vic.com](http://www.ku-vic.com) by **April 1, 2019.**

- Abstracts presented must contain body of work which has not been published however previously presented or updated data is also eligible.
- The scientific conducts presented in the abstract must comply with international standards pertaining animal utilization ethics and intellectual property rights.
- Each author needs to select the submission form either oral or poster presentation during submission process.
- The abstracts with good English and in correct format will be processed for the peer review.
- The process of peer review will be conducted by the scientific committee
- The authors will be notified about reviewer’s comment through the email as provided at the abstract submission
- The authors who receive the revision must re-submit a file within one week after notification.
- The authors cannot either replace or modified the abstract during the process of submission
- The abstract acceptance notification will be sent with the abstract number which will be referred in all correspondence.
- The accepted abstract will be included in the scientific program and the conference proceeding only after the presenting authors complete their registration by **May 31, 2019.**
- The first author or co-author is expected to attend the conference and give the presentation and notify the organizing committee if there are any change regarding the presenting author.
- For the poster presentation, it is expected that the author(s) will be present at the poster location during the specified presentation time(s) to discuss the contents with the congress participants.

### **Format**

- The file must be prepared in the word document (\*.doc, \*.docx) with Microsoft word version 2007 or higher.
- The length of an abstract is limited to 350 words with 3-5 key words.
- The content includes five sections; Introduction, Objectives, Methods, Results and Conclusions.

## **ORGANIZATION OF ABSTRACT**

### **1. Page setup**

- A4, portrait, margins: top: 1.25'' bottom 1.25'' left 1.50'' and right 1.25''
- Single space.

### **2. Title**

- Times New Roman, 12 points, bold type, centered, limited to 25 words without space in UPPER CASE

### **3. Authors**

- Times New Roman, 10 points, bold type, center for author name.
- The name of the presenting author must be in underline and the corresponding author is emphasized by an asterisk (\*).
- Corresponding authors must provide E-mail address and phone number.
- Use numbering behind authors corresponding to each author's affiliation.
- Times New Roman, 10 points, regular type, centered for affiliation.
- Affiliation details: department, institution, address number, street name, city, state (if relevant), country, postal code.

### **4. Keywords**

- Times New Roman, 10 points, bold type, centered, 3-5 words. Keywords should be in alphabetical order.

### **5. Abstract content**

- Times New Roman, 11 points, regular type, justified, must not exceed 350 words.
- Separate the content as following topics
  - Introduction:
  - Objectives:
  - Methods:
  - Results:
  - Conclusions:
